The following instructions must be adhered to in order to avoid personal and serious injuries, property damages and potentially fatal electric shocks. Switch off the power at the circuit breaker/fuse before installing, repairing and cleaning the unit.

Make sure the unit is appropriate for the intended use (if needed, refer to the product catalog or a representative).

- 1. Remove access cover to the control box of heater.
- 2. Install the thermostat on the bracket. FIG. 1
- 3. Connect the two black wires supplied with the kit to the thermostat terminal. FIG. 2
- 4. Insert a white insulation sleeve on the wire coming out of the thermostat. FIG. 3
- 5. Fix the bulb in place on the motor housing with the plastic support provided in the kit. FIG. 4
- 6. Connect one black wire from the thermostat to block C and the other black wire to block 1, FIG. 5 (or see electrical diagram).
- 7. Re-install access cover to control box.


